Guidelines for grant aid towards D.L.I. Residential Summer School 2018

For the 19th year, a limited number of grants are being made available by the Arts Office, Waterford City & County Council to individuals who are attending the D.L.I. 53rd Residential Summer School at the University of Limerick from 28th July to 4th August 2018.

The level of grant aid assigned to applicants is at the discretion of the selectors and may be assigned between a number of candidates. Priority will be given to new applicants.

Waterford City & County Council reserve the right not to award any bursaries under this scheme.

It is the responsibility of applicants to secure a place on their chosen course directly with the D.L.I. in advance of making this application for grant assistance and to pay the non refundable deposit required.

You must be an active member of a drama group based in Waterford to be considered for this grant aid. You must be resident within Waterford City & County Council's administrative area for a period of no less than two years.

Application forms must be co-signed by the current Secretary or Chairperson of the drama group to which you belong.

Individuals who are selected for grant aid will be informed in writing. Grants where assigned will be paid directly to the D.L.I. on the recipients behalf.

Payment will not issue until the DLI have confirmed that you have paid any balance involved and attended the course.

A short written report of your experience at the Summer School must be submitted to the Arts Office on completion of the course.

No correspondence regarding decisions will be entered into.

Signing the application forms implies the individual's acceptance of these conditions.

Completed application forms must be submitted to the stated address only on or before **12 noon on Thursday 3rd May 2018**. Late applications cannot be considered.
